KENTUCKY CAR WRECK ATTORNEY RELEASES CONTROVERSIAL ARTICLE ON “AMBULANCE CHASERS”

Nothing in life or the practice of law disgusts me more than the term ambulance chasers. What does this term mean? It means “those that work for unethical lawyers” and make a living by exploiting the pain, suffering and misfortunes of others. I would like to use this article to distinguish what I do for my client’s as opposed to how ambulance chasers abuse people who have already become victims of a tragedy. The first thing that distinguishes me from ambulance chasers is that I do not contact a person who has been in an accident; I wait for them to contact me. I am bound by the toughest, most respected Professional Rules Of Conduct of any profession. On the other hand, Ambulance Chasers are not bound by such strict Rules. They use third party companies to contact people immediately

after they have been in an accident. Sometimes potential clients are contacted by these ambulance chasers before the official police accident report is even ready.

Once I am contacted and retained as counsel, I begin an investigation into the facts of the accident, injuries of my client(s), and whatever property damage that was incurred by the accident. I review medical records and reports, order accident reconstruction reports, and conduct interviews with all parties involved in the accident. I find out who is responsible for the injuries of my client and I hold that person or corporation accountable.

Ambulance chasers habitually associate with Attorney's that settle cases for a fraction of what the client is actually entitled to and then leave the client stranded once they receive their fee. I make sure I am not paid until my client is fully satisfied, and will no longer be burdened by the inconveniences an accident can produce. I care for my clients, and in return my clients care for me. The practice of law is a community based service. Attorneys should not lose sight of the fact that we are here first and foremost to make sure our client's rights are being protected.
