LEGAL TIPS FOR MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND

1. **KEEP YOUR CAR IN GOOD WORKING ORDER.** Make sure you check all of your lights to make sure that they are functioning. Make sure you check tire pressure, oil and engine temperatures as this could be several of the warmest days of the year. We have received many calls at our office lately of motorists getting pulled over because a light on their car was out. We have even gotten reports that motorists will be stopped and ticketed for not having their License Plate eliminated.

2. **OBEY ALL TRAFFIC LAWS.** On holiday weekends, such as Memorial Day, there will be an increased Police Presence. The Kentucky State Police, Kentucky County Sheriff's Offices and City Police Departments in Kentucky will work together to crack down on motorists violating traffic safety laws. Here are FOUR DON'T's for the Holiday Weekend:

DON'T SPEED!

DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE!

DON'T GET CAUGHT NOT WEARING YOUR SEAT BELT!

AND DON'T GET CAUGHT WITHOUT PROPER INSURANCE AND REGISTRATION!
